

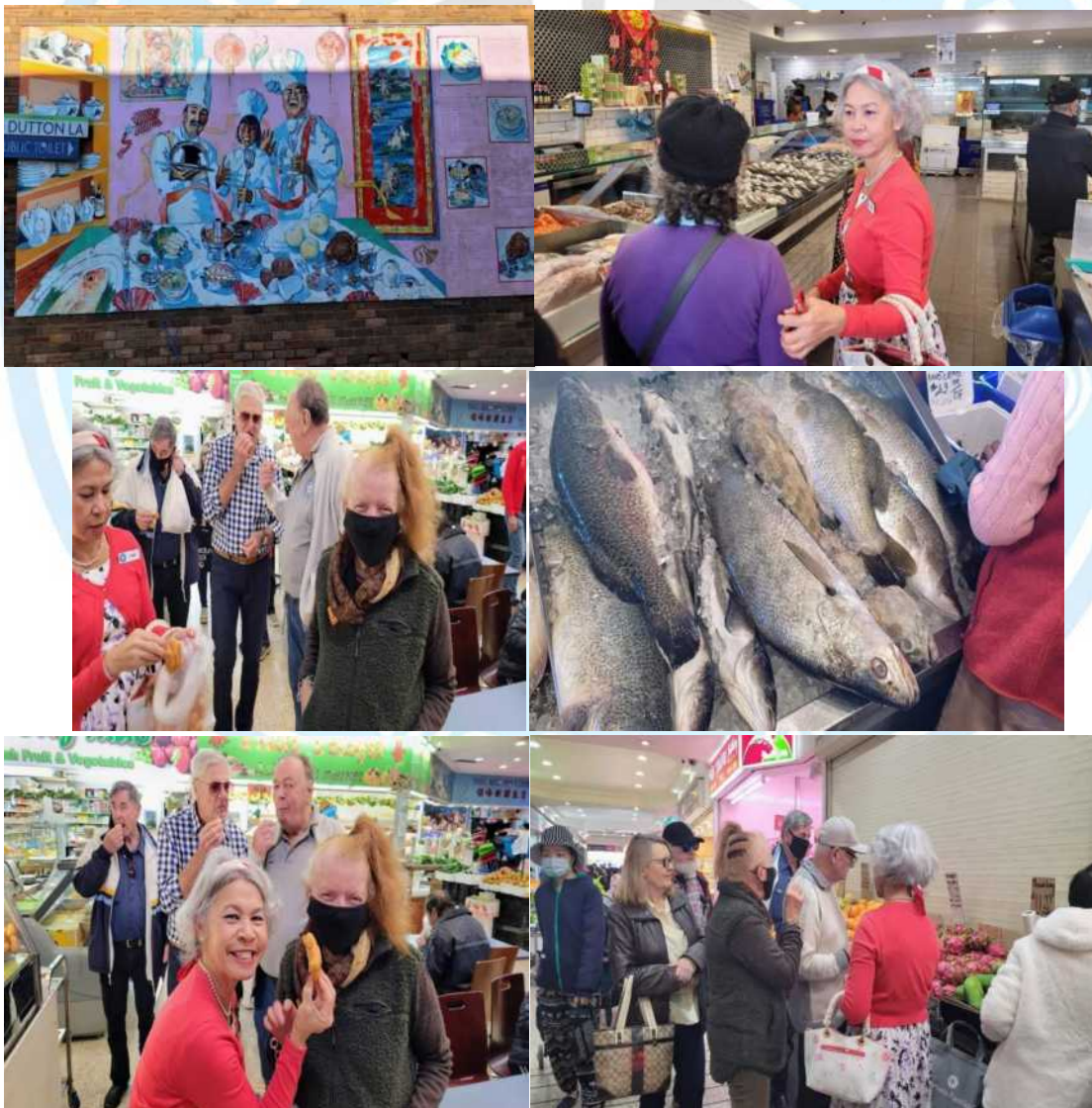
## A Taste of Vietnam, Cabramatta.
