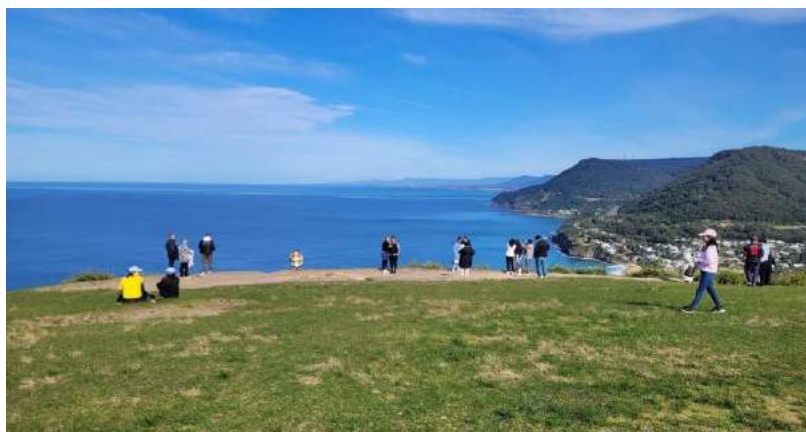


Midweek drive to Helensburgh.
