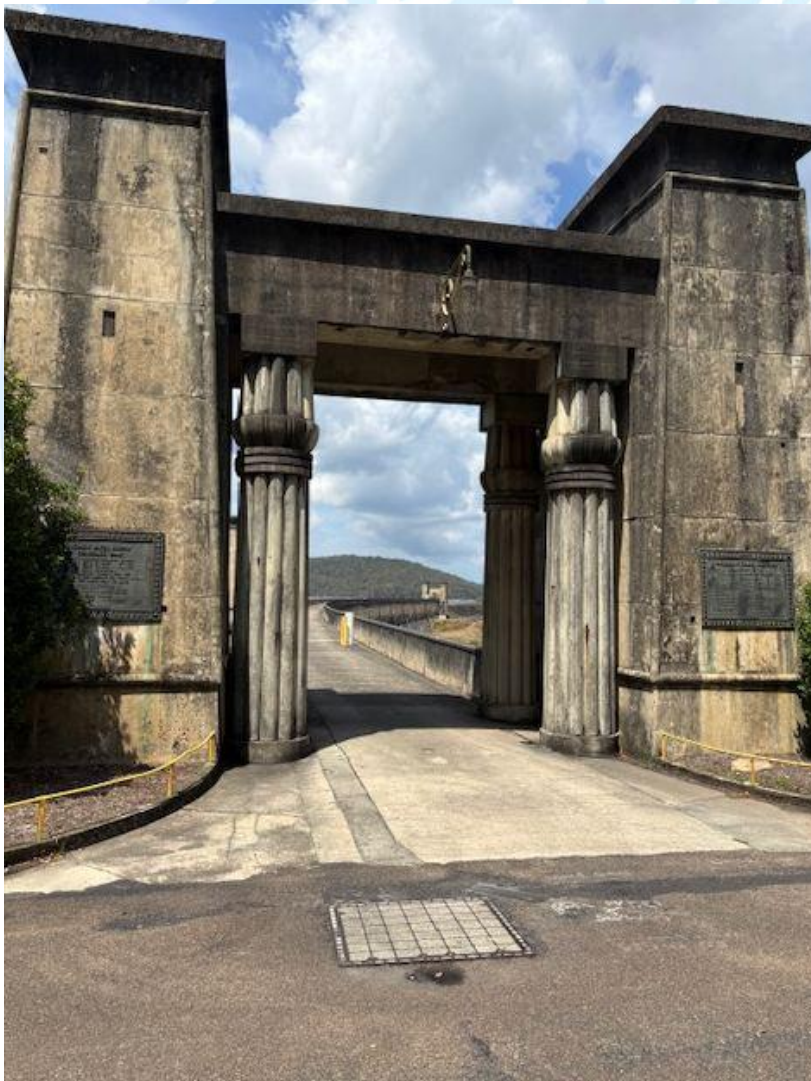


Cordeaux Dam NSW!

Cordeaux Dam was started in 1918 and completed in 1924, the second of 4 dams to collect water from the Illawarra Plateau. Remarkable for its Egyptian inspired architecture, due to the popularity of all things Egyptian, with the discovery of King Tut's tomb in 1922.

Did anyone notice the memorial plaque to the resident engineer Guy Chalmers-Clift, who was shot along

with Constable Flynn, in a bungled payroll robbery in 1924. Their killer was hanged in Long Bay later that year.
