of the Historic Vehicle Scheme (HVS) have been met.

- 1 ☐ The owner is a financial member of MCCNSW.
- 2 ☐ The vehicle is 30 years old or more, calculated from the month of build (if known).
- 3 ☐ The vehicle is less than 3.5 tonne Gross Vehicle Mass (GVM).
- 4 ☐ The vehicle is normally garaged in NSW.
- 5 ☐ The vehicle complies with HVS period options, accessories, and safety items.

- 6 ☐ The Historic Vehicle Declaration form No.1259 is complete and less than 42 days old when presented to Service NSW for registration purposes.
- 7 ☐ For INITIAL or RENEWAL of HVS registration, the declaration is accompanied by a hand written safety inspection report (pink slip) less than 42 days old.
- 8 ☐ For INITIAL (**ONLY**) registration on HVS, the Application for Conditional Registration form No.1246 is complete.
- 9 ☐ Date stamped photos less than 30 days old of front, rear, sides, interior, and engine bay.
